**Revision policy for data reported and published for statistical purposes
for the year 2011 and previous years.**

Methodological guideline

This methodological guideline sets the rules for the revision of data in the reports submitted to the National Bank of Slovakia by individual reporting entities for statistical purposes¹.

The guideline also regulates publishing of statistical data on the web site of the National Bank of Slovakia.

The revision policy specifies the following revision types:

1. actual reference period T,
2. ordinary revisions, which refer to the last reference period T-1,
3. exceptional revisions, which refer to the previous reference periods (T-2, ... T-j),

T – Current reference period

The following rules are set for publishing of statistical data on the National Bank of Slovakia web site:

1. Data for the current reference period T, as well as revised data for the period T-1 (*ordinary revisions*) are published on the web site on the last working day of the month (T+1) as specified in the Table, column 4.

Data for the current reference period T are marked with (p) as preliminary data.

2. *Exceptional revisions*, which refer to the previous reference periods (T-2, ... T-j), are published on the web site on days specified in the Table, column 3.
Revisions performed within the exceptional revisions are published on the web site as news.

3. Revised data for the first quarter of 2011 are published on the web site on the last working day of June 2011.
4. Revised data for the second quarter of 2011 are published on the web site on the last working day of September 2011.
5. Revised data for the third quarter of 2011 are published on the web site on the last working day of December 2011.
6. Revised data for the fourth quarter of 2011 are published on the web site on the last working day of April 2012.
